Beyond the library catalogue: Services of the University Library Frankfurt in the area of Linguistics

Two central infrastructure facilities for the linguistic research in Germany are hosted by the university library Frankfurt. Those are i) the Lin|gu|is|tik-Portal (<u>www.linguistik.de</u>) and ii) the Specialised Information Service Linguistics (<u>FID Linguistik</u>).

The Lin|gu|is|tik portal is a research instrument for the general and comparative linguistics, and the linguistics of single languages. There you can find discipline-specific scientific resources of every type: from conventional secondary literature (printed and online) to digital information resources including research data. Currently, more than 2.4 million linguistically relevant titles are researchable via the virtual catalogue. A great number of the resources are directly accessible online - either as open access publications or via the IP-range of the university as they are licenced by the local library or the FID.

The Lin|gu|is|tik portal offers, besides the relevant search functions, access to services in the area of Linked Open Data, E-Publishing and literature acquisition. The improvement of the portal and the expansion of the services are funded by the DFG program "Fachinformationsdienste für die <u>Wissenschaft</u>" since 2017. The Lin|gu|is|tik portal is the official web presence of the FID Linguistik. There you can find all relevant information as well as access to the specific FID services such as corpus licences and e-journal hosting.

In our talk we will present all modules of the Lin|gu|is|tik portal. We will further demonstrate the search functionalities and inform about current and future FID Linguistik activities, especially in the area of corpora and research data.

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
