Abstract

Thanks to the RTG, the university library could extend the institutional license for the sketchengine platform (https://www.sketchengine.eu/) till March 2023. Sketchengine provides access to corpora for many languages, together with automatic annotation tools and a comfortable query interface. All functionalities of the platform are well documented, including through video tutorials (https://www.youtube.com/c/SketchEngine). The aim of my presentation is to invite you to make use of this rich resource in your own linguistic practice. We will look at some basic functions which I have been using in my own teaching and research. We will address the following topics:

- Selecting a corpus
- Formulating queries
- Display options
- Exporting results
- Creating your own corpus

For preparation

It would be good if you all created your sketchengine account before the meeting. I will be in the room at 4.00pm to go through the steps with those of you who have not. This is how you do it:

- 1. Go to https://www.sketchengine.eu/
- 2. Click on "Log In"
- 3. Choose "Institutional login" (on the right site of the screen)
- 4. Look for Universität Frankfurt and click on it.
- 5. This will get you to a login page of our library. Type in the same information that you use for the library, olat, etc.
- 6. You will then be asked to create an account on sketchengine. Please do this and confirm the account if necessary!
