# Grammar 24: Selecting for particular words

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#### A new head feature: LEXICAL-ID

## Examples: depend on

```
egin{bmatrix} {\sf Word} \\ {\sf PHONOLOGY} & \Big<{
m on}\Big> \\ {\sf SYNTAX} & \left[ egin{bmatrix} {\sf preposition} \\ {\sf LEXICAL-ID} & {\it on} \end{matrix} 
ight] \end{bmatrix}
```

# Examples: look the word up

```
\begin{bmatrix} \textit{word} \\ \textit{Phonology} & \left\langle \textit{up} \right\rangle \\ \textit{SYNTAX} & \begin{bmatrix} \textit{preposition} \\ \textit{LEXICAL-ID} & \textit{up} \end{bmatrix} \end{bmatrix}
```

## Examples: It rains.

```
\begin{bmatrix} \textit{word} \\ \textit{Phonology} & \left\langle it \right\rangle \\ \textit{Syntax} & \begin{bmatrix} \textit{head} & \begin{bmatrix} \textit{noun} \\ \textit{lexical-id} & \textit{it-expletive} \end{bmatrix} \end{bmatrix} \end{bmatrix}
```

## Examples: It smokes.

```
\begin{bmatrix} \textit{word} \\ \textit{PHONOLOGY} & \left\langle it \right\rangle \\ \textit{SYNTAX} & \begin{bmatrix} \textit{noun} \\ \textit{LEXICAL-ID} & \textit{non-selectable} \end{bmatrix} \end{bmatrix}
```

#### **Excercises**

- Parse the words "on", "up", and "in" and inspect the results. Note the different values of the new head feature LEXICAL-ID!
- Now check what kind of complement the two words "depend" and "look" require. Again, note the value of the complement's head feature LEXICAL-ID!
- Parse the word "rain"! What is noteworthy about it?
- Parse the word "it"! Why do you get so many solutions?
- Parse test items (275)-(294) and explain why you get the results you get and their number!

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
